

HOW TO CREATE AN AUTO PUNCH

An auto punch is a quick way to punch the market based off of a numeric sample element.

- 1) Create a dummy question with as many punches as there are markets in your study.
- 2) For each punch, type the text of your market preceded by an asterisk.

Example: *Scottsdale

- 3) For the final punch, type the sample element that corresponds to your numeric market code.

Example: [2]##

Note: The sample element for market must be numeric.
